## Our Schedule

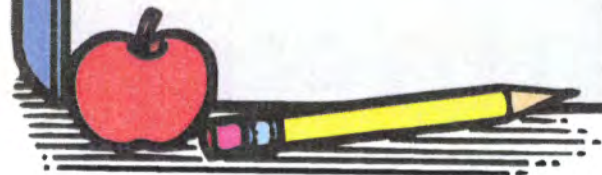
MTA & Kindergarten Class

## Our Curriculum



Preschoolers learn best through play, hands-on experiences, and personal observations. All of our classes use the WEE Learn Curriculum published by LifeWay Christian Resources. It uses themes and activities to teach preschoolers language, reading, writing, math, and other age-appropriate foundational skills. It also teaches children about God, Jesus, the Bible, self, family, others, and the natural world.

In addition, K3 and K4 use the phonics curriculum, "Sing, Spell, Read and Write", go on Field Trips, and may participate in our optional classes of CompuChild and Stretch 'n Grow . K2 - K4 also have Spanish, Science, Art, Music and P.E. classes on a rotation basis.
